Chart 1. Tutoring by Subject

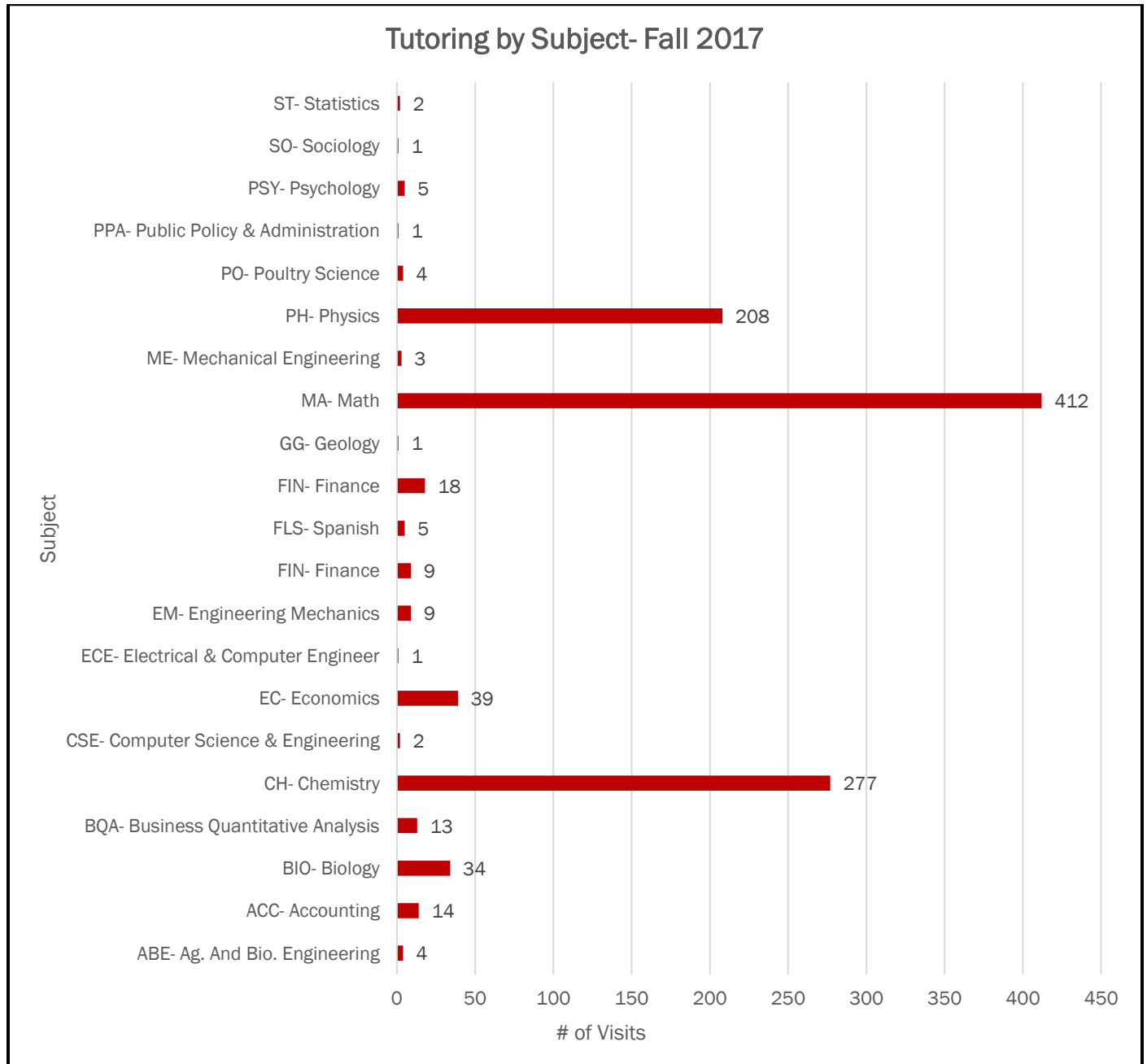
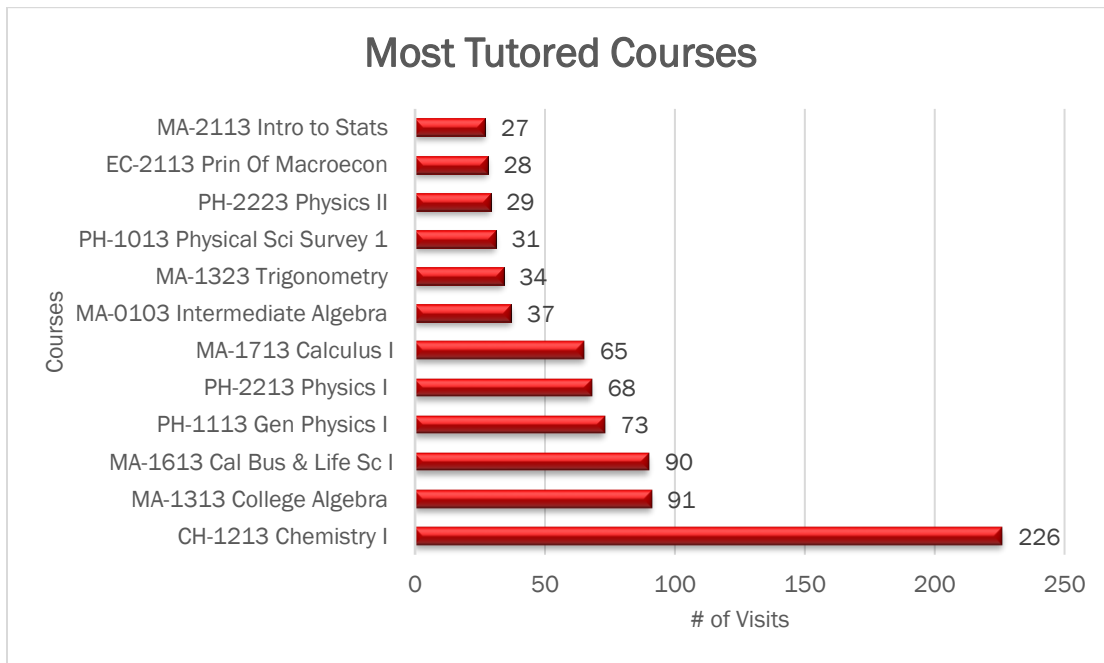


Chart 2. Most Tutored Courses

Chart 3. Tutoring by Month

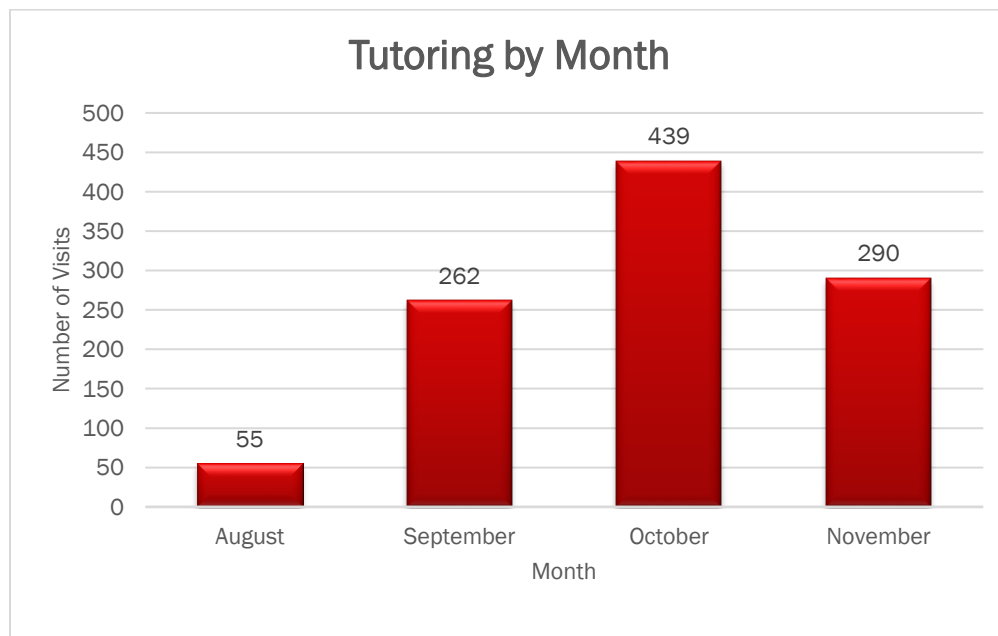


Chart 4. Tutoring by Day of the Week

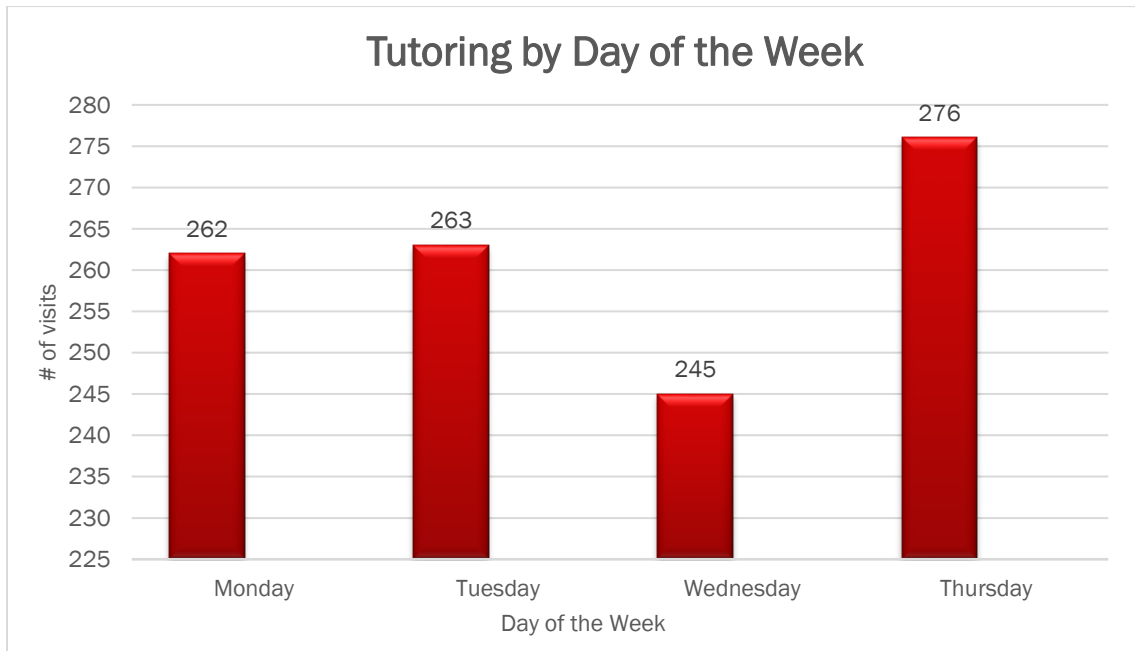
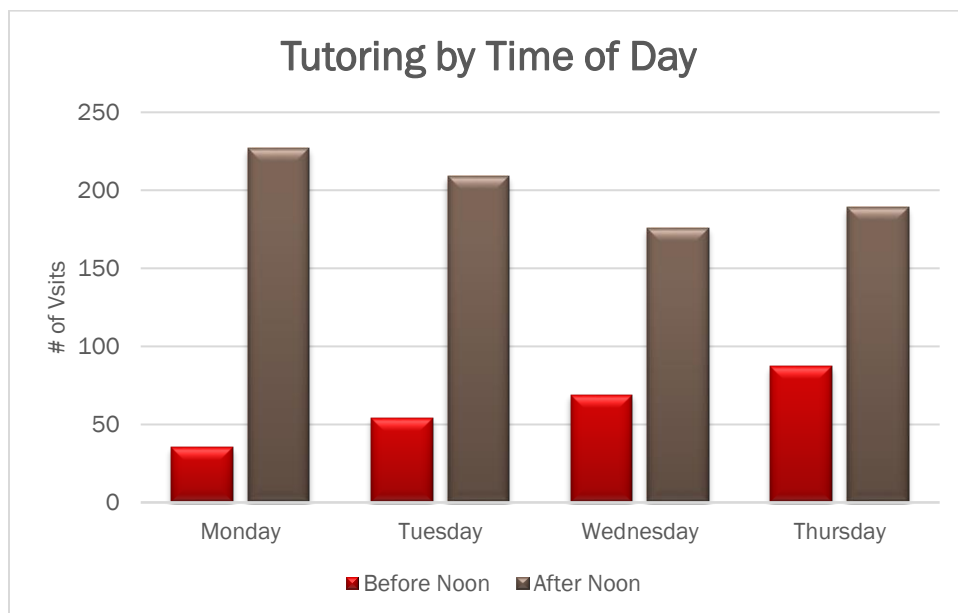


Chart 5. Tutoring by Time of Day

Chart 6. Visitors by College

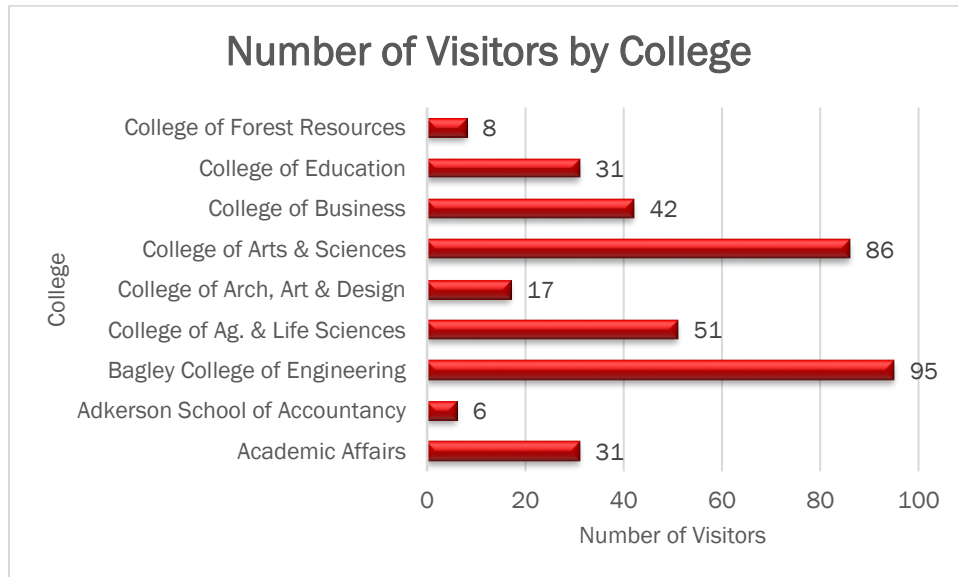


Chart 7. Returning Visitors

Chart 8. Visitors by Gender

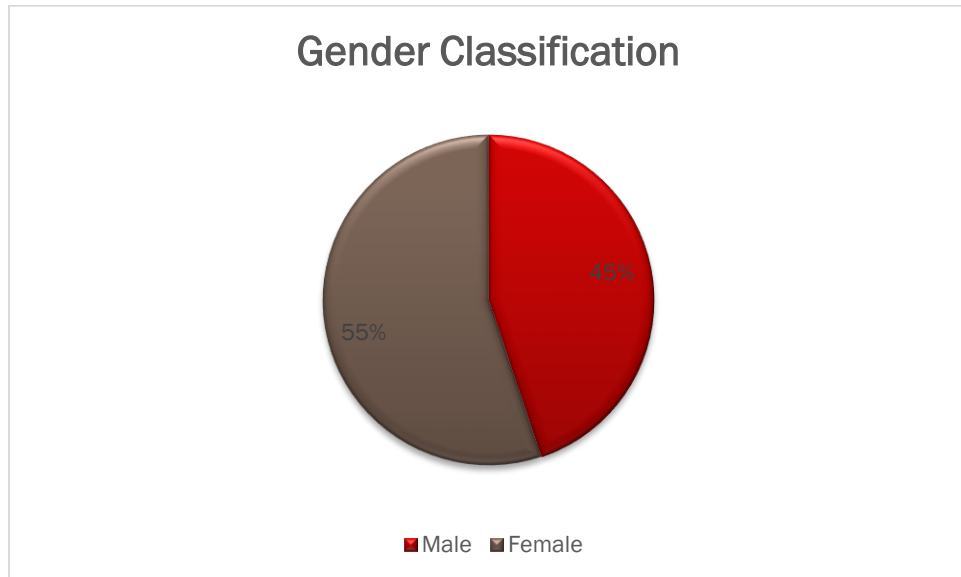


Chart 9. Visitors by Classification

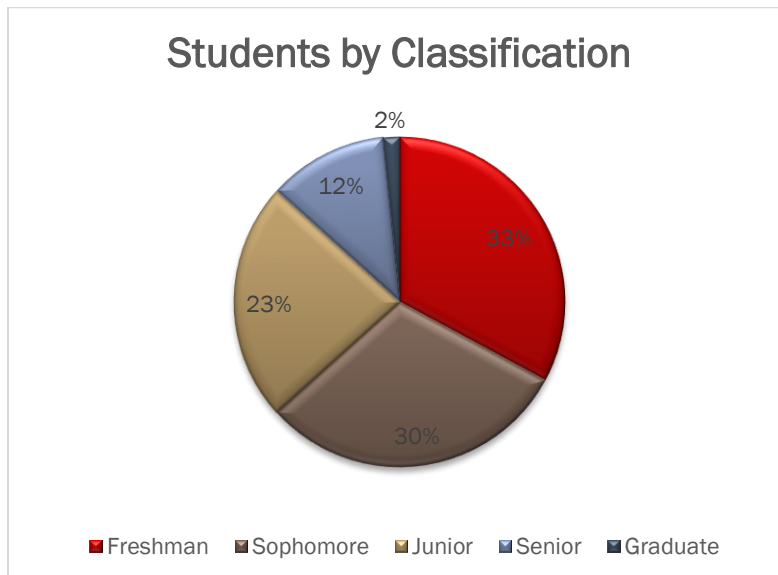
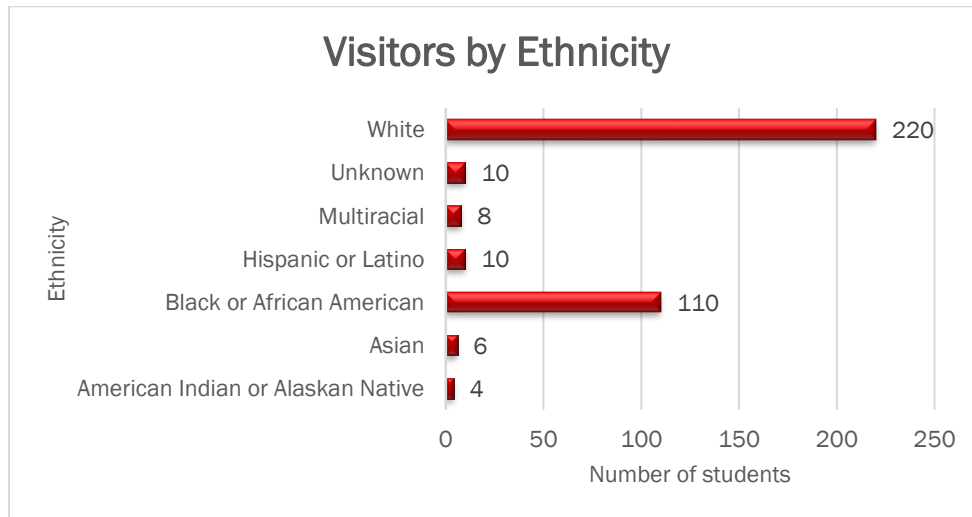


Chart 10. Visitors by Ethnicity

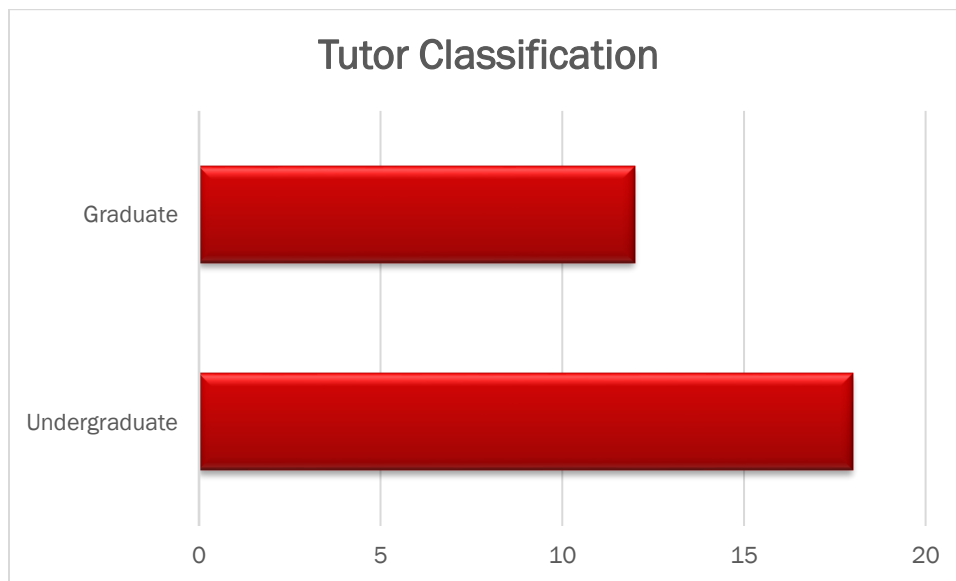

Chart 12. Visitors by Semester

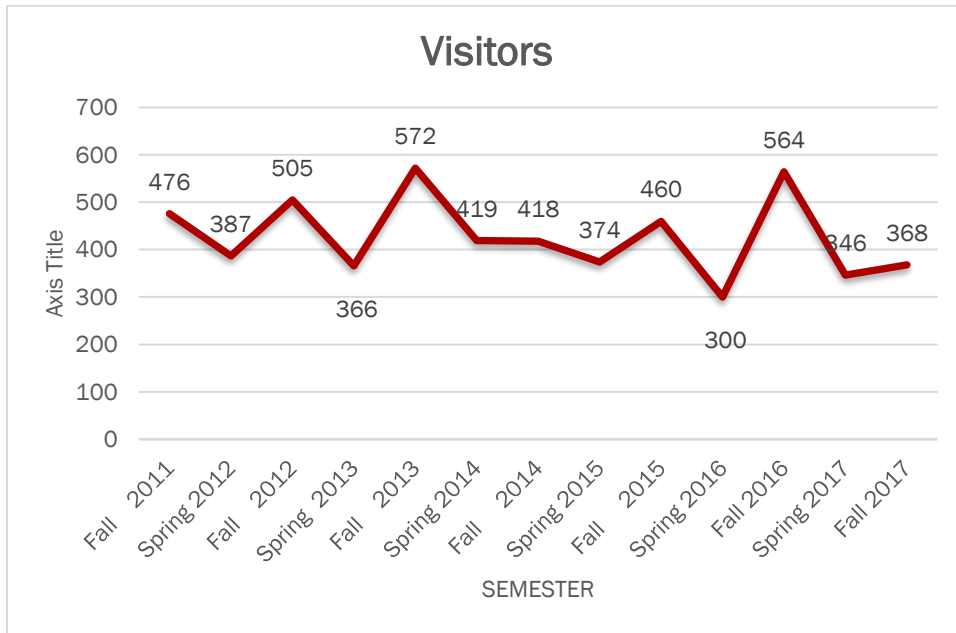


Chart 13. Tutors by Semester

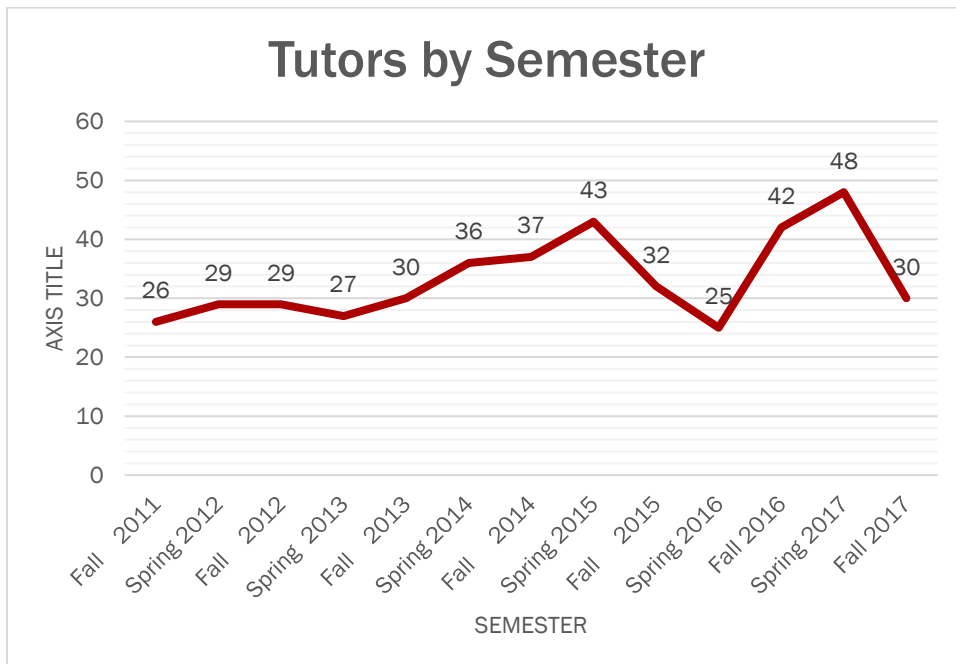


Chart 14. Tutors by Payment Method
